Today there are nearly 13,000 churches in the U.S. with nearly 3 million members and adherents. Our 16 Fundamental Truths



This “Statement of Fundamental Truths” contains the 16 doctrines of the Assemblies of God. These are non-negotiable tenets of faith that all Assemblies of God churches adhere to. Four of these, Salvation, the Baptism in the Holy Spirit, Divine Healing, and the Second Coming of Christ are considered Cardinal Doctrines which are essential to the church’s core mission of reaching the world for Christ.

ASSEMBLIES OF GOD STATEMENT OF FUNDAMENTAL TRUTHS

The Bible is our all-sufficient rule for faith and practice. This Statement of Fundamental Truths is intended simply as a basis of fellowship among us (i.e., that we all speak the same thing, 1 Corinthians 1:10; Acts 2:42). The phraseology employed in this Statement is not inspired nor contended for, but the truth set forth is held to be essential to a full-gospel ministry. No claim is made that it covers all Biblical truth, only that it covers our need as to these fundamental doctrines.

What is “Ohio for Jesus”?

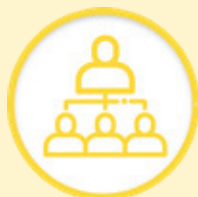


Ohio for Jesus is the 10-year strategic vision of the Ohio Ministry Network launched in 2020. Because we recognize that a broken society is the outflow of a weakened church, we want to see the church, a sleeping giant, awoken to develop and deploy Spirit-empowered leaders for healthy, multiplying churches and ministries and see people forgiven, healed, and whole.

Sensing the Spirit's clear direction to move forward in statewide unity, Network leadership conducted a massive statewide survey while our presbyters and ministry directors were led on a strategy and vision-building journey. Ohio for Jesus then came about after hearing of the prayerful development and implementation of a strategic 10-year plan by the Assemblies of God in Tanzania. The Ohio Ministry Network sent a delegation of leaders

to observe firsthand what God can do when a group of churches and leaders unite to impact their communities for the Gospel of Jesus Christ. Through several years of prayerful consultation in Ohio and finding confidence in the Tanzanian story, along with multiple confirmational moments, God positioned Ohio to develop and engage in its own strategic plan, Ohio for Jesus.

This initiative consists of four major areas that we call drivers. Each of the drivers has one major goal broken into three key result areas. These goals were set through careful prayer and asking Ohio pastors and local church leaders what they believed the Lord was directing them to accomplish locally in each driver. Our statewide totals reflect numbers submitted by each participating church.

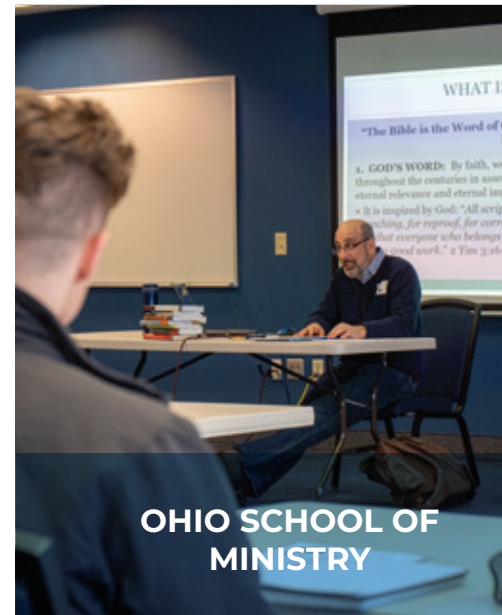
CHI ALPHA

Ministerial Relationships & Credentials with the Assemblies of God



FELLOWSHIP AND TRAINING AT THE LOCAL AND STATEWIDE LEVELS ARE A NORMAL PART OF LIFE FOR MINISTERS IN OHIO.



THE 3 LEVELS OF CREDENTIALS WITH THE ASSEMBLIES OF GOD

- Certified
- Licensed
- Ordained

MINISTRY DESCRIBED

Christ's gifts to the Church include apostles, prophets, evangelists, pastors and teachers (Ephesians 4:11), exhorters, administrators, leaders, and helpers (Romans 12:7,8). We understand God's call to these ministry gifts is totally within His sovereign discretion without regard to gender, race, disability, or national origin.

Three classifications of ministry are recognized and transferable among all Assemblies of God districts: the ordained minister, the licensed minister, and the certified minister. All ordained, licensed, and certified ministers holding current ministerial credentials are authorized to perform the ordinances and ceremonies (sacerdotal functions) of the church.

Church Partnership & Affiliation

COOPERATIVE FELLOWSHIP

Cooperative Fellowships are local congregations which agree with the Statement of Fundamental Truths of the General Council of the Assemblies of God and desire to enter a cooperative relationship with the Ohio Ministry Network on a temporary basis (4-year term, renewable by the request of the local church congregation at the discretion of and in cooperation with the General Council Executive Presbytery) before officially affiliating with the Ohio Ministry Network and/or the General Council.

Cooperative churches do not have the same privileges and responsibilities as General Council or Network Affiliated churches.

Cooperative churches receive all Ohio Ministry Network mailings/emails and are welcome to attend network events. Additionally, they have access to network tools/resources, etc.



NETWORK AFFILIATED CHURCH

Network affiliated churches are local congregations in initial or transitional stages of development toward greater maturity and/or health. These local congregations are under the general supervision of the network presbytery, which provides for pastoral care, appoints the necessary officers, etc., until such time as the local congregation gives evidence of sufficient maturity to warrant full recognition as a General Council affiliated church.

A Network Affiliated church must have at least fifteen (15) bona fide members, three (3) of whom can qualify for appointment as members of the Advisory Committee.

Church Partnership & Affiliation

GENERAL COUNCIL AFFILIATED

General Council affiliated churches are local congregations which have matured sufficiently to accept their full share of self-governance and financial responsibility for the maintenance of scriptural order. They are organized under the guidance of the Ohio Ministry Network, with proper governance and corporate documents. They cooperate with the Assemblies of God Fellowship in doctrine, in conduct, and all other matters which may affect the peace and harmony of the whole.

A General Council Church must have at least twenty (20) bona fide members, three (3) of whom can qualify for consideration and election as officers of the assembly.

The assembly may not have any outstanding obligations for which the Ohio District Council, Inc. of the Assemblies of God or The Board of Trustees of the Ohio District Council, Inc. of the Assemblies of God is liable, either as a primary obligor or a guarantor.





PARENT AFFILIATED CHURCH (PAC)

A Parent Affiliated Church (PAC) is an outreach of an existing General Council Affiliated Church or duly authorized Network Affiliated Church resulting in a worshiping community with a congregational life distinct from the Parent Church.

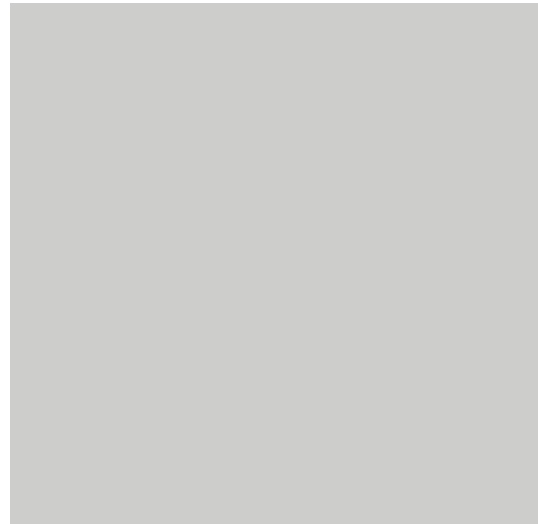
A PAC is subject to the ecclesial supervision and authority of the parent church, in such manner, and upon such terms and conditions, as are determined by the parent church.
